School Lunch

Chartwells, our food services provider, has some great new ideas and food creations to make lunch fun and taste great!

- The cost of a full priced meal is \$3.30. A milk without a school lunch or an additional milk is \$0.40
- Students whose families qualify for *reduced cost* lunch through the Free and Reduced Lunch Program will pay \$0.40 for the standard meal.
- Students who qualify for *free lunch* through this program will still receive lunch free.
- A full meal consists of a meat/meat alternative (Chicken patty, meatballs, string cheese, yogurt, etc), grain (hamburger bun, pizza crust, dinner roll, etc), at least one fruit and vegetable, and a milk.
- Students have access to unlimited fruits and vegetables.

If you wish to apply to participate in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program, an online link will be available on the Xavier website. We will no longer be accepting paper applications. Also, you may **CLICK HERE** to start your application.

School Dress Code

The school dress code guidelines are for students in grade kindergarten through grade 4 only. Please be sure to read this over carefully as it is an expectation for students to dress according to the dress code. Please note that this dress code does not apply for our 3k and 4K students as they are encouraged to dress in comfortable play-wear that they can easily pull down to go to the bathroom quickly and without assistance for frequent bathroom breaks. Please note that these dress code guidelines are for students at the elementary campuses only, so be sure to read them carefully because once students move on to middle school and high school, there are a few more options and choices available. I wanted to be sure to clarify as it can get confusing for families with students at several campuses.

Daily School Schedule and Care Programs
