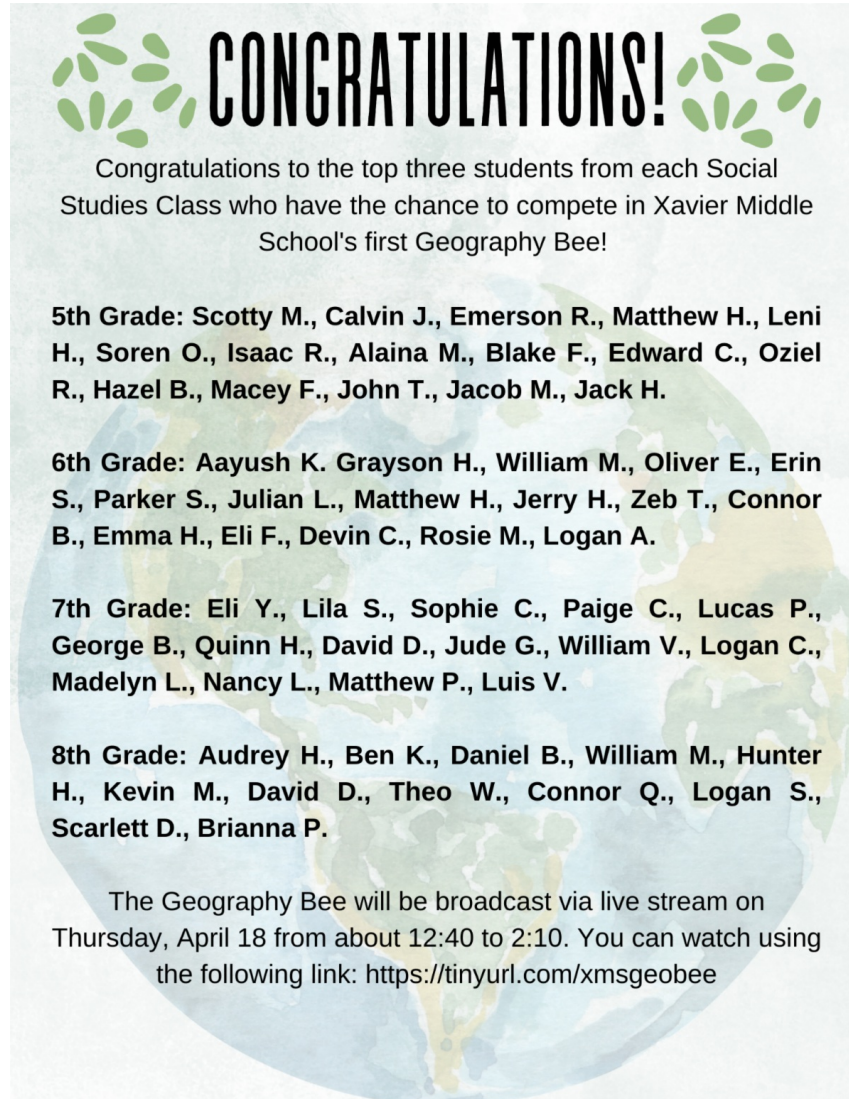
Wednesday, April 24th, 6:00 pm at Xavier Middle School Auditorium
