- <u>Click here</u> to go to the Celebrate GiveSmart website. Once there, click on the "Items" tab, which will allow you to view the auction items.
- If you are not attending, but would like to bid, click on an item which will prompt you to create an account and register a credit card to begin bidding. You are only charged if you are the winning bidder.
- If you are attending, you should have received a welcome text and/or email with a link. Once you have confirmed via the link & registered a credit card, you may begin bidding. Please only use the link and do not create your own account as you will then have two accounts at Celebrate.
