#### **Important Lunch Account Information**

Starting on Monday November 6h, any student with a negative \$10.00 or larger lunch balance will only be able to receive a full meal. This means you will not be able to buy an extra entrée, a second milk, or any other ala carte items, so please look at your lunch accounts and add funds if needed.

Here at Xavier Middle School we offer unlimited fruits and vegetables with all meals! The cost of a full priced meal is \$3.40 and \$0.40 for reduced price. A milk without a lunch or an additional milk is still \$0.40 and any additional entrée with a full meal is going to cost \$2.15. If you don't buy a full meal, the cost of just an entrée is \$3.50, so we urge you to swing by our fresh salad bar and grab a fruit or a vegetable to save some money! A full meal consists of a meat/meat alternative (Chicken patty, meatballs, string cheese, yogurt, etc), grain (hamburger bun, pizza crust, dinner roll, etc), at least one fruit and vegetable, and a milk.

If you qualify for free or reduced meals, please make sure and take a full meal, otherwise you will get charged for every item separately and not get the free or reduced rate!
